- Born on 13.09.1959 in the town of Biia, Alba County.
- Graduated in 1978, Theoretical High School no. 2 from the town of Tîrnăveni as Head of Promotion.
- Since 1979, he has been a student of the Faculty of Medicine in Cluj-Napoca, a faculty graduated in 1985 as Head of Promotion.
- Since 1985 he has been a resident doctor at Cluj-Napoca County Hospital, and after 1988 a general practitioner at Borșa Municipal Hospital, Maramureș County.
- Since 1990 he has been a Teaching Assistant at the 2ⁿ Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, "Iuliu Hațieganu" University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Cluj-Napoca. He goes through all stages of didactic hierarchy, and since 2013 is a University Professor.
- Since 1998 he has been a primary obstetrician-gynecologist and has been practicing medical activity at the "Dominic Stanca" Obstetrics and Gynecology Clinic, Cluj-Napoca.
- He holds certificates of complementary studies in the following fields: Ultrasound in Obstetrics-Gynecology (1997); Health Services Management (2005); Colposcopy (2011); Laparoscopic gynecologic surgery (2012); Hysteroscopy (2013); Maternal-Fetal Medicine (2016).
- Is involved in the academic and postgraduate educational process, being a residency coordinator in obstetrics and gynecology.
- Has participated as author or co-author in the development of 16 monographs and manuals.
- The research activity was materialized as a director, coordinator, collaborator or mentor in 17 international, national or internal research grants.
- Has published over 120 articles, including 50 ISI and 28 BDI. HIRSH Index (Science Core Collection Web) 9.
- Has achieved the title of doctoral supervisor following his assertion thesis in 2014, and coordinates a number of 6 PhD students.
- At present, is the Head of "Dominic Stanca" Obstetrics and Gynecology Clinic, Emergency County Clinic Hospital, Cluj-Napoca, and the Head 2nd Obstetrics and Gynecology Discipline at "Iuliu Hațieganu" University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Cluj-Napoca.
- Is a member of the Faculty of Medicine Council and the Senate of the University, and also a member of the Disciplinary Committee of the Cluj College of Physicians and of the Obstetrics and Gynecology Commission of the Romanian College of Physicians.
