Graduate of the Faculty of Medicine of the Institute of Medicine and Pharmacy Cluj-Napoca, class of 1977. Intern at the Institute of Oncology, Cluj-Napoca, starting 1977 and from 1980 member of the teaching staff of the Institute of Medicine and Pharmacy Cluj-Napoca. In 1991 he took his PhD degree and in 2001 became Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology at the University of Medicine and Pharmacy Cluj-Napoca. He coordinates PhD theses since 2002.

Between 1997-1998 he was Head of the Department Obstetrics and Gynecology II, Emergency County Hospital Cluj, between 2002-2009 and 2012-2016 Head of the Department Obstetrics and Gynecology I, Emergency County Hospital Cluj and during the period 2005-2007 he was Head of the Public Health Department Cluj.

In 2009-2012 he was Prefect of Cluj County.

Between 2010-2014 he was the Director of Implementation of the IMOGEN Project, and starting 2014 up to the present he has been Managing Director of the IMOGEN Institute (a multidisciplinary research center for the study of embryo-fetal pathology).

During 2012-2015 he was Head of the Mother and Child Department of the University of Medicine and Pharmacy Cluj-Napoca and during 2012-2017 Head of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at the University of Medicine and Pharmacy Cluj-Napoca.

Starting 2016 up to the present he has been a Deputy in the Romanian Parliament, Vicepresident of the Health Board of the Chamber of Deputies.

He participated in several training modules such as those at the Université Catholique de Louvain, Cliniques Saint-Luc (Belgia), Hospices Civils de Lyon l'Hotel (Franța), Edith Margraff Comunication (Franța), Universita Degli Studi di Perugia (Italia), The Fetal Medicine Foundation (Anglia).

He has been a member of the Ministry of Health Committee since 1997.
