

## Associate Professor Gheorghe Oto Furău, MD, PhD

Medical doctor Furău Gheorghe is the head of Obstetrics and Gynecology Department in Arad Emergency Clinical County Hospital.

He graduated Emanuil Hojdu High School in Oradea, then in 1983 the Faculty of General Medicine in the Timisoara Institute of Medicine.

He started as general medical doctor between 1983-1990 in Varadia de Mures, Pecica and Arad Dispensary. In 1994 he finalised the internship in obstetrics and gynecology at Bega Clinic in Timisoara, under the guidance of Acad. Prof. Ioan Munteanu MD, PhD and

continuing his practise as a gynecologist in Arad and Lipova.

By winning the contest as a physician inspector between 1995-2000 he also worked in the Arad Public Health Department. After that he practised as General Manager and Head of

Physiological Obstetrics Department in "Dr. Salvator Vuia" Hospital of Arad County and finally, as Head of Obstetrics and Gynecology Department in Arad Emergency Clinical County Hospital.

In 2003 he received the title of Doctor of Medicine, currently a primary specialist with multiple skills.

In collaboration with the Universities of Szeged (Hungary), Novi Sad (Serbia), Timisoara and Oradea and as a member of the "Egon and Ann Diczfalusy" Foundation, together with the Western University "Vasile Goldiş" in Arad, Dr. Furau Gheorghe organized many international and national scientific manifestations with international participation, that enjoyed the support of the Romanian Society of Obstetrics and Gynecology, the Romanian Society of Minimally Invasive Surgery in Gynecology.

Dr. Furau Gheorghe has published as an author and co-author 8 books and book-chapters, 21 ISI and ISI PROCEEDINGS articles, 34 BDI/B + articles, more than 100 articles published in other magazines and papers presented in national and international scientific events and is the winner of 14 awards for scientific activity and 7 grants / research projects.

Of great interest and the main goals are: the construction of a new maternity hospital in Arad, and on the civic level, the development and integration of the Arad Fortress in the city circuit
