It was founded in 1997 and currently has 32 member countries, including Romania, since 2005.

The main objectives of this organization are to achieve the highest standards of training in gynecology obstetrics and, in the same time , to improve the quality of health care.

ENTOG also encourages international exchanges and interaction between training residents and their European counterparts in order to ensure a homogeneous training of specialists in the field and to ensure a comparable training standard.

ENTOG activity is being carried out in close collaboration with EBCOG (European Board and College of Obstetrics and Gynecology) to establish the criteria to be met by the specialized training centers in each Member State.

ENTOG has actively collaborated on the development of EBCOG-PACT-Project for consensus in training, postgraduate training curriculum for obstetrics and gynaecology.<http://entog.eu/pact/>

Romania joined the ENTOG family in 2005, through the Association of Residents and Young Specialists-AGORA, with the official presentation of the Romanian training program at the ENTOG Council.

AGORA has so far gathered 160 members, residents doctors and young specialists, with the same preoccupation to obtain a training in the field comparable to the standard established at an European level.

Since 2004 (one year before official acceptance) and until now at the last ENTOG Council at EBCOG Paris 2018, Romania has been a constant presence with active participants in annual meetings and even a member of the ENTOG Executive Committee during 2006-2008 .
